# GENERAL Tournament RULEs \& Info ("The Battle in the Valley" Tournament) 

1.The Official Senior Softball-USA Rulebook 2021-22_shall be used for any rules not mentioned below.
2. SCHEDULED GAME TIME is FORFEIT TIME: All teams must be ready to play fifteen (15) minutes prior to their scheduled game time, or immediately following the previous game.

## 3. TOURNAMENT FORMAT:

DAY \# 1 (Sat.) ... "Pool Play"
Each team will play 3 Round Robin "Pool Play" ('Seeding' games) on Sat. ... EACH gm . will be $\mathbf{6 0} \mathbf{~ m i n}$. in length. A coin toss will determine the HOME team, \& the VISITORs will be allotted $+\mathbf{1} / \mathbf{2}$ run (to eliminate ties). The $\mathbf{+ 1 / 2}$ run will NOT be used in either 'bracketed' Championship tourneys. After fifty-five (55) minutes of play, the next inning will automatically become the "OPEN (scoring) INNING". The 4th "Pool Play" will be played on Sun. morning @ a time yet T.B.D.'d
_ DAY \# 2 (Sun.) ... Championship Tourney ... ‘seeded' \& 'bracketed"
The Championship game will be a full 7 innings, \&, in the event of a tie, we will use the 'International Tie-Breaker' protocol to determine a winner ... in the 8th inning, the last batter from the previous inning will start @ 2nd base with one (1) out), \& we will play on until a winner is determined
4. \# of "GUARANTEED" gms.: 5
5. To ensure the protection \& safety of the pitchers, ALL teams MUST play w/a mask

## 6 . Age \& Rosters

_ This will be an eight (8) team tournament, w/the allowable 'age range' of the participating players being from $\mathbf{5 5 - 7 0}$ yrs. of age, ALL rostered players must be at least 55 yrs. of age.
_ The roster size will have a limit of 16 . Player ratings must be designated when the roster is submitted, \& the roster can consist of 55 \& 60 Major, AAA, AA, and/or A rated players.
_ Roster changes will be accepted only at 'check-in' on DAY \# 1 only
_ The tournament director(s) reserve the right to award teams 5-7 runs, based on team ratings, to promote competitiveness.
7. BATTING INFO: ALL batters will start with a $\underline{1}$ ball- $\mathbf{1}$ strike count. Foul balls are strikes, w/NO 'courtesy foul to waste' after the second strike. ONLY bats w/a $\mathbf{1 . 2 0}$ or less rating can be used. ALL other bats will be deemed illegal, \& the player using one will be ejected \& disqualified from the tournament immediately. ONLY 1.21 bats or lower, or, approved ASA bats will be allowed.
8. PITCHING POSITION: The pitcher will be allowed an $\mathbf{8} \mathbf{f t}$. $\mathbf{x} \mathbf{2} \mathrm{ft}$ ' 'pitching
lane' behind the rubber from which to deliver the ball. A 6' - 12' arc must be maintained.
9. LINEUP INFORMATION: A nine (9) player minimum will be required to start/finish a game. However, you may bat your entire roster. Any player playing in the field must also bat. The Umpire (s) will keep the 'official score', \& will declare the score after each half inning.
10. Player ELIGIBILITY: A player will NOT be allowed to play in Sun.'s

Championship round unless he has batted in @ least once in two (2) of the three (3) "Pool Play" gms. on Sat. It will be the responsibility of EACH MGR. to make sure that ALL 'rostered' players fulfill Rule \# 9, \& bat @ least one (1) time per gm. Field moderators will record every player $A B$ for the entirety of each gm. to ensure compliance to this rule.
11. In order to ensure participation, \& compliance w/Rule \# 8, this tournament will use the "Modified Subsitituion Re-Entry" format. All starters can be substituted for once \& can re-enter once. That player must re-enter in his same position in the batting order. Players used as courtesy runners can run multiple times in a gm., but NOT more than once per inning. Players who take a courtesy runner, may not be a courtesy runner for someone else in the same inning.
12. MERCY RULE: Teams can only score a maximum of four (4) runs per inning, w/the final inning being the 'open' or unlimited inning. Any team ahead by twelve (12) runs after 5 innings shall be declared the winner. The 'Flip-Flop' rule will be used in the open inning for home team trailing by (10) or more runs.
13. HOME RUN RULE: EACH team will be allowed ONLY three (3) HR's per game. There will be NO "1 Up" HR rule in effect. ALL subsequent HR's hit by a team that already has hit 3 HR's will be "OUTs".
14. PLAYER SAFETY: All pitchers will be required to wear a facemask. Any player initiating undue contact with another player shall be called out in the umpire's discretion \& may be subject to ejection.
15. PROTESTs: There will be absolutely NO protests allowed. All umpire decisions are FINAL
16. "SEEDING" ... Bracket Placement ... Criteria (in the order presented)

1) Won/Loss record,
2) head-to-head competition,
3) least runs allowed,
4) most runs scored
and/or
5) coin flip
17. "Zero Tolerance" Rule: The City of Peoria, \& the Peoria Parks \& Recreation Department reserve the right to determine discipline, including ejection, whenever a player's violates the tournaments accepted code of conduct. Unsportsmanlike conduct \& actions such as fighting, abuse of the officials or recreation staff, and/or any other example of
misbehavior will not be tolerated, \& dealt w/accordingly. Any player or coach ejected will be subject to a MINIMUM one (1) game suspension
18. WEATHER: Tournament officials \& staff reserve the right to make changes to the tournament rules \& formats in the case of inclement weather conditions.
19. Entry Fee REFUNDS: A definitive ruling on refunding the Entry Fees for participating teams, in the event of inclement weather after the tourney starts, will be made by, \& at the discretion of the tourney host ... "Launchers" Softball.
