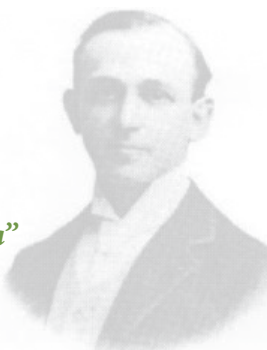

Who can conquer The Georgia Jewel?



The Georgia Jewel is one of the most challenging trail running races in the state. Organized by Jenny and Franklin Baker, the 100 mile run lasts over 24 hours and pushes experienced runners to go above and beyond. Each September, Dalton sees visitors from across the country and abroad who have taken up the ultimate challenge: the Pinhoti Trail. A section of the 245 mile trail system connecting to the Appalachian Mountain Trail sends the competition through rewardingly tough terrain and beautiful vistas of the hills and valleys you won't find anywhere else in the country.

Part of the Capehart Trail, this 20 mile offroad vehicle system of forest trails branches throughout the Beautiful Chattahoochee National Forest. Perfect for Motorcycles and ATVs, the 2-way trail is considered to have a "Black Diamond" difficulty with easier trails marked.

Rocky Face Ridge is a multi-purpose park and trail with amenities for outdoor enthusiasts. At the summit is a picturesque view alongside a number of original Civil War fortifications.

Just a 45 minute drive from Dalton, this beautiful park is set around a deep gorge cut into the mountain by Sitton Gulch Creek, and features two waterfalls. Visitors enjoy beautiful views, hiking, tennis and disc golf.

Johns Mountain | Pinhoti Trail

Adventure on the Pinhoti Trail

With Dalton being a central hub for hiking in North Georgia, you are only a short drive to any location on the Pinhoti Trail - one of the most diverse and accessible hiking trails in the region. This 245 mile multi-trail system connects the Blue Ridge Mountain foothills to the Talladega National Forest and is the longest footpath in the state. Shaded and lightly trafficked, the many trails along the Pinhoti offer beautiful scenery and views for hikers of any experience level.

3 Dug Gap To Snake Creek Gap Trail (Medium)

This 15.7 mile point-to-point trail offers spectacular views from the mountain and rock features that characterize the Appalachian foothills. The trail is open to hikers, mountain bikers, campers and even horseback riders.

9 Pilchers Pond

Pilchers Pond to Snake Creek Gap is a challenging but beautiful 11.3 mile trek perfect for mountain biking, camping, and hiking. The picturesque beauty of the pond and the mountain views make this Pinhoti trailhead a can't miss opportunity for nature lovers.

A popular 1.8 mile loop, this moderate trail takes hikers through beautiful oak-hickory woods full of rock formations set into the Johns Mountain. In the spring the waterfall that gives the trail its name pours out from the mountain - offering a spectacular view at the overlook observation deck.

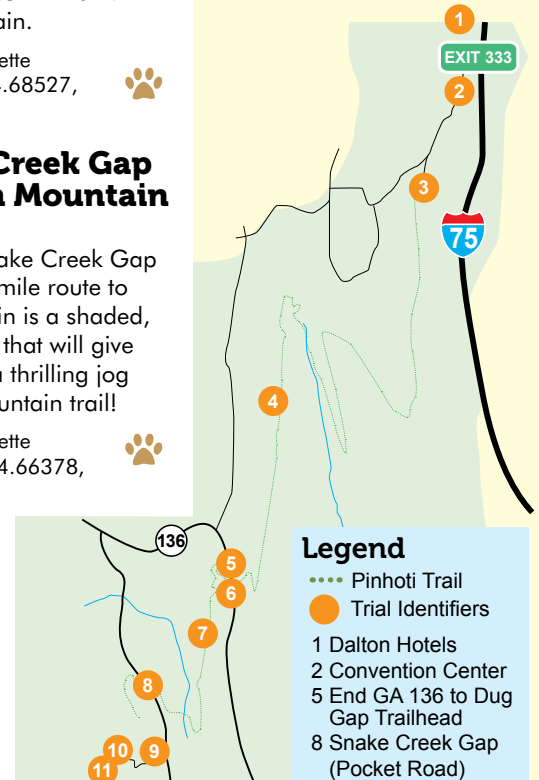

Par 2 Disc Golf

Play the nation's only permanent **disc golf course** in a downtown business district. This is a PAR2 course and features 8 holes. Prodigy Discs are available at the visitor center's gift shop to purchase.

Will Schusterick: A Disc Golf Prodigy

Dalton is home to Prodigy Disc – a company founded by World Champion disc golf players who design discs for flight and accuracy. Part-owner Will Schusterick started playing professionally at age 16 and in 2012 became the #1 ranked and rated player in the world. In February 2020, Schusterick directed The Pasture Open by Prodigy. The new course was the proving ground for 176 players across all age divisions – bringing Disc Golf to a new generation. Prodigy also designs courses. “... I get inspired by the land and its features...” says Schusterick when discussing how he designs new courses. “When a player is coming back ‘wanting more’ from the course I think the goal has been accomplished.”

The Conasauga River runs through Southeast Tennessee and through Whitfield County. The river flows off the inclines of the Northwest Georgia Mountains before it passes through the peaceful Cohutta forests.

Surrounded by over five miles of wooded hiking trails, the lake has two floating piers for fishing, kayaking and canoe launch with seasonal rentals. The park is complete with a picnic pavilion, playground, bathrooms and parking so you can spend the day in the scenic beauty of Dalton.

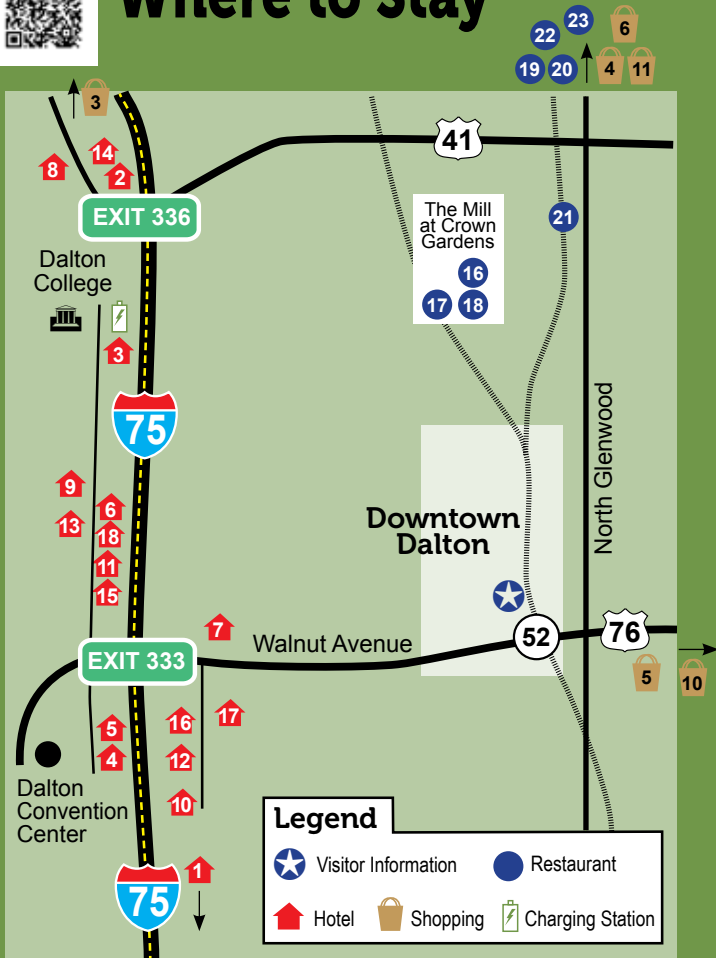

Tunnel Hill Heritage Center

Experience a marvel of engineering up close! The historic Western & Atlantic Railroad tunnel, completed in 1850, was cut, blasted and built by hand through the Chetoogeta Mountain as the final link between Chattanooga and Atlanta. The original bricks you see in the walls of the tunnel were also used to build The Clisby Austin House – a farmhouse built by a Methodist minister and used as a headquarters by General William T. Sherman while planning the Atlanta Campaign.

Our local historians of the Tunnel Hill Heritage Museum will guide you through the 1,477 foot long tunnel, explaining the construction of the tunnel and The Great Locomotive Chase – the daring story of the Civil War spies who attempted to steal a locomotive and sabotage the railroad.
