

# Walnut Creek Athletic Complex

## May 2021 Tournament Protocol



All spectators, coaches, athletes, officials, vendors, City of Raleigh employees, etc. are required to comply with federal, state, and local COVID-19 guidelines, and Walnut Creek Athletic Complex (WCAC) rules and regulations. Failure to abide could result in removal from the complex.


### Tournament Directors:

- Face coverings are required for anyone (ages 2+) entering the concourse area surrounding the tower including bathrooms, food vendors and while entering and exiting the facility.
- **Official play will take place on the designated fields (Fields 1,2,3,5,7,8,9)**, and practices will be held on these designated fields (Fields 4,6 and open space at Wheel 2).
- **Each team will be allowed 35 spectators** (of any age), spectators names will be recorded following the completion of their wellness check prior to receiving their colored wrist band and entering the complex (wristbands are non-transferrable). Once a team has met its max of 35 spectator and further spectators will not be permitted into the complex.
- Tournament directors should schedule at least 15 minutes between games to allow for all high touch areas to be disinfected. These areas include dugouts, fences, and bleacher areas.
- All tournaments will be charged at the Tier 2 fee structure, \$25 per team per day rate while COVID-19 restrictions require modification to facility occupancy for the month of April. Contact-less admissions will be implemented for the month of April with the allowance of 35 spectators per team, per day at a rate of \$140 per team, per day (the flat rate, per team, per day removes incentive per admissions and will not be reflected as discount based on rental fee structure). This fee will be charged to the Tournament Directors, and tournament Directors should collect this directly from teams. (Example: 40 teams at \$25 per day for 2 days=\$2,000.00 plus 40 teams x \$140 contact-less admission x 2 days= \$11,200.00, which reflects a total due to WCAC of \$13,200.00)
- Tournament directors will send PDF's of all registered teams rosters to WCAC Facility Director, at least 3 days prior to the start of the tournament.
- Players will be allowed to enter the facility 1.5 hours prior to their game time, and spectators will not be allowed to enter until 45 minutes prior to their teams game time.
- All players, spectators, officials, vendors, tournament staff, City of Raleigh employees and everyone entering the facility will go through a wellness check consisting of a touch-less temperature check and the answering of a few questions.
- Players will receive a colored wrist band upon completion of the wellness check and spectators will receive a different colored wrist band before entering the complex. This wrist band will allow all participants to enter and exit the facility.

### Spectators/Participants:


- Face coverings are required until spectators are set up in their viewing area, where they are able to remove masks when they can maintain a 6' physical distance from non-household members at all times.
- **Face coverings are required for anyone entering the concourse area surrounding the tower including bathrooms, food vendors and while entering and exiting the facility.**
- Spectators will be allowed to enter the complex 45 minutes prior to their teams game time, players will be allowed to enter 1.5 hours prior to their game time.
- Coaches must wear face coverings at all times, unless they are able to maintain 6' of physical distancing from non-household members.
- Players must wear face coverings at all times, except when on playing field or they are able to maintain 6' of physical distance from non-household members.
- No touch rule; players should refrain from high fives, handshake lines, and other physical contact with teammates, opposing players, coaches, umpires and fans. A "tip of the cap" can be used following the game in lieu of the handshake line.
- No spitting or eating seeds, chewing gum, using tobacco products, or other similar products.

Mask Zone

- Masks must be worn until spectators are set up in their viewing area, where they are able to remove masks when they can maintain 6' of physical distance from non-household members.
- Masks are required for anyone entering the concourse areas surrounding the Tower, restrooms, and Food Truck Plaza (except when consuming beverage or food).
- A list of attending food trucks will be distributed to tournament directors 3 days prior to tournament date(s) so that participants and spectators are aware of vendor menus and pricing.
- Seating is available throughout the concourse with marking to identify social distancing requirements.
- Spectator seating for game viewing is only permitted beyond the bleacher seating along the 1st and 3rd baseline fencing towards outfield. Bleachers are not open to spectators as they are only for dugout overflow player seating so that social distancing is achieved. Spectators must bring own lawn chair. No seating will be distributed nor available by WCAC. Tents are permitted and must follow these guidelines: All tent, canopy or open air structures, including inflatable structures must meet IFC-2006 requirements. All components, materials or similar material must be flame retardant. Tent weights should be used to secure tents as tent stakes are not recommended.
